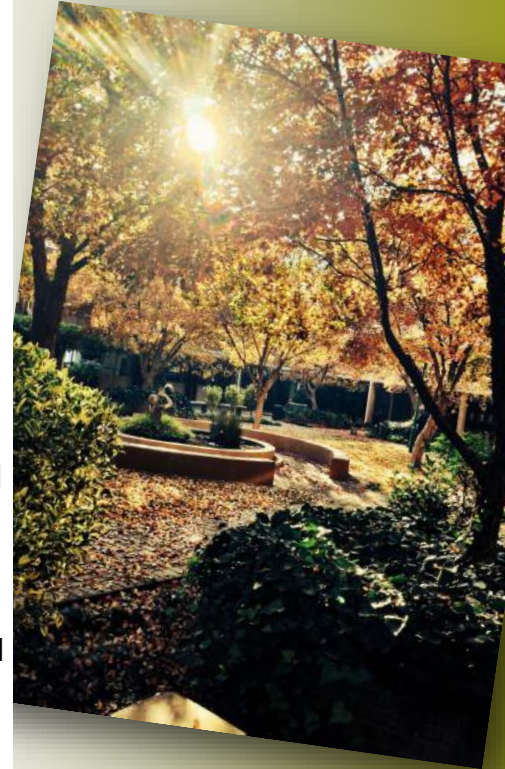


Farewell

Proud moments

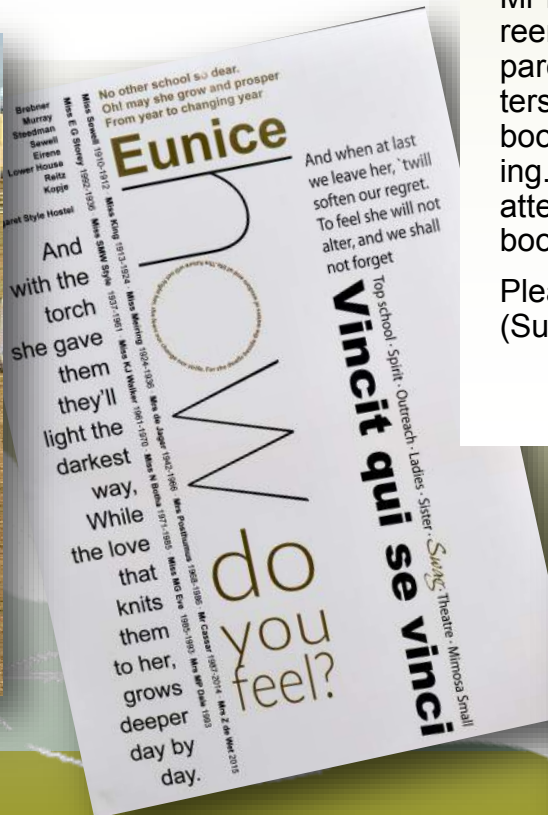
