Dear Parents

We have entered the final stretch of the academic year and we know how hard our learners have worked to achieve their goals throughout the year. It is our hope that every learner will prepare herself thoroughly for the final assessment and that she will experience, once again, how it feels to conquer herself. The following exam arrangements have been discussed with learners. Please support our staff by also discussing the content of these documents with them. Included in this Newsletter is the full end-of-year exam timetable.

1. Learners are to line up in alphabetical order, per class group, outside the indicated exam venue, 30 minutes before the starting time of exams.
2. The school grounds are a silent area during the end-of-year exam.
3. Normal school uniform and appearance rules apply.
4. No eating, drinking or chewing are allowed in the exam venue (Water bottles must be left outside the exam venues).
5. All notes and bags are to be put outside the exam venue.
6. Pencils, highlighters, pens and erasers will only be allowed in the exam venue if packed in a see-through plastic sleeve/bag (No pencil cases are allowed).
7. No TIPPEX is allowed in the exam venue.
8. Please come to the exam venue fully equipped and prepared. Borrowing will NOT be allowed. Calculators must be in the right mode and must be in perfect working order (An extra set of batteries could prove to be useful).
9. Please leave cell phones at home. No cell phones are allowed in the exam venue. Please place your cell phone in an envelope, clearly labelled with your name, and submit to the invigilator before every session should you choose to bring it to school.
10. Bathroom visits are only allowed in papers longer than 2 hours (Bathroom visits not allowed in the first hour or last half hour of a paper if the paper is longer than 2 hours).
11. The Office must be informed immediately in the event of a learner being absent, either by means of a telephone call or an email to mail@ehs.co.za or don@ehs.co.za. Upon returning to school the learner needs to see Dr Don Paine immediately.
12. Learners will not be allowed outside a study or exam venue for longer than 40 minutes before an exam or 30 minutes after an exam. Learners who have to wait for longer periods must report to the allocated study venue.
13. No candidate may be dismissed earlier than the end of any exam session.
14. The school day will end at 13:00 except for sessions starting later (Provision has been made for supervised study before and after every exam session, depending on which session learners write on a particular day).
